



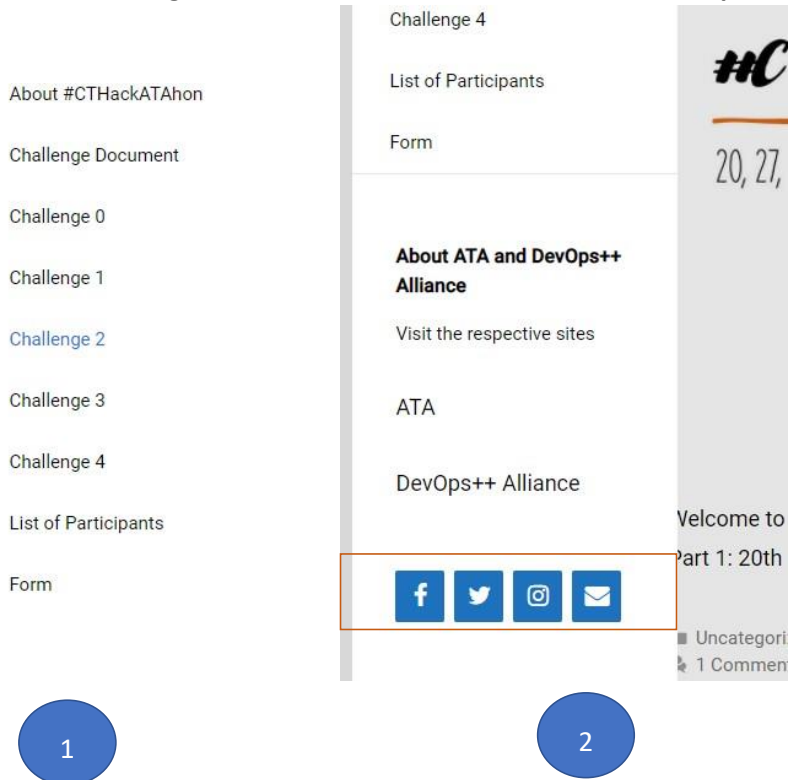

- For all the social media icons, find the respective urls of all the social media icons and print them on system console (1 in figure above)
- Right click on all the social media icon one by one and open them in a new window. Get the title of the new window and print the same on the system console (2 in figure above)

Do the following steps in a data driven test format. Use @DataProvider or similar way to execute the following steps for the given excel sheet below.

- Create a data driven test, such that for every row in the figure above, it is able to confirm if the details are true and match one of the rows for participant table or not.
- If the details are matching, it should write to a separate file. e.g for Test 1, it should write Test 1 <details> Passed other wise failed.

Please note that every row must be run as a separate test. In other words, you should not validate all the rows of the excel sheet in one test.

Marks will be given only if the test is data driven. No marks will be given if the test is not data driven.

- Create a POM Question3POM for list of Participants page

Following methods needs to be implemented in POM class

A. List <String> searchParticipantName(String Name)

The method in the POM class should be able to search for the participant name and return a list of Names found. e.g. on searching for “ch” it should return the respective names in a list. If no names are found it should return a blank list.

B. List <String> searchParticipantDesignation(String Name)

The method in the POM class should be able to search for the participant name and return a list of designations found for all the rows. e.g. on searching for “ch” it should return the respective designations in a list for all the rows. If no names are found it should return a blank list.

Create a separate Junit Test, such that the above POM class object is created, the method/function are called and the values received from both the functions are printed on system console properly.

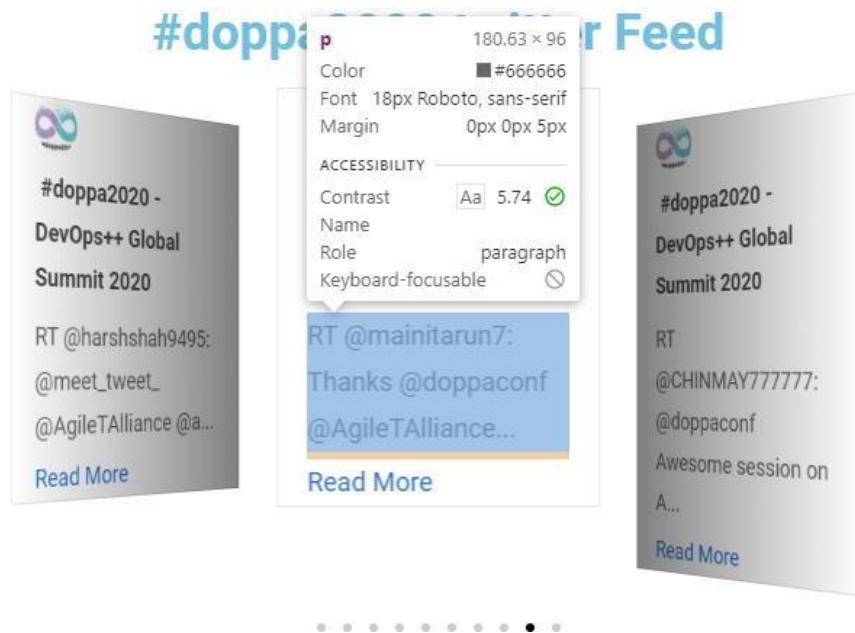

2. The choice of browser to be used for running the respective test should be passed as a parameter. – **parameter passing 4 marks (this can be done either in TestNG or in JUnit)**
